


KEDARNATH TREK

Duration: 5 Days 4 Nights.

family.


Start point: Rishikesh/ Haridwar.

Endpoint: Rishikesh/ Haridwar.

Difficulty of the trek: Easy to moderate.

What will you get: stunningly scenic landscapes, inner

harmony, enchanting prayers of Hinduism.





"KEDARNATH"-The highest of the 12 Jyotirlingas

Gaurikund -The place where Lord Shiva had confessed his love for Goddess Parvati, also where Lord Ganesha had acquired his famous "elephant-head" figure.

Tungnath Mahadeva - Highest temple dedicated to Lord Shiva.

Chandrashila - "Moon Rock".

Rudraprayag -This pristine town is nestled on the holy confluence of Alaknanda and Mandakini rivers.

Devprayag - Devprayag is the last Prayag or the holy confluence of the Alaknanda River.

Rishikesh - The place which gives you both spiritual and adventuzous atmosphere.





Description

Kedarnath is one of the holiest pilgrimages to the devout Hindu. It is set in the stunning landscape of the Garhwal Himalayas at the head of the **Mandakini River**. **Kedar** is another name for **Lord Shiva**, the protector and the destroyer. The shrine of Kedarnath is very scenic and is surrounded by high, snow-covered mountains and, during the summer, grassy meadows covering the valleys. Kedarnath is situated in the Himalayas above **3,583 m (11,755 ft)** above sea level near the **Glacier of Chorabari**, the source of the **Mandakini**.

Chopta Tungnath trek is one of the largest shiva temples in the world and the **highest Panch Kedar** temple in Uttarakhand. This shiva temple is **1000 years** old and is situated at an altitude of **3,680 m (12,073 ft)** and just below the height of **Chandrashila**.







Short Itinerary

Day 01: Morning Departure From Haridwar/Rishikesh, Later Drive To Chopta 8-9 Hrs Drive(211 Kms).


Day 02: Chopta – Tungnath Chandrashila Trek (5 Kms Trek). Later Last Drive To Sitapur 2 Hrs Drive(54 Kms).


Day 03: Morning Sitapur Drive To Gauri Kund 7km And Then Trek Towards Kedarntha Peak (21 Kms Trek).

Day 04: Trek Back To Gauri Kund, Then Night Stay Sitapur.

Day 05: Morning Sitapur Drive To Rishikesh 207km.









Day 01: Morning Departure From Haridwar /Rishikesh, Later Drive To Chopta 8-9 Hrs Drive(211 Kms).

- Departure from Haridwar/Rishikesh in the morning.
- Travel to Chopta after pickup (8-9 hrs drive).
- Arriving at Chopta in the evening, take some rest for a bit.
- Later you can explore the surrounding areas on your own. enjoy the beauty of nature throughout the evening.
- Enjoy your campsite meal, a bonfire, a community activity.
- Remain at Chopta for the night.









Day 02: Chopta-Tungnath-Chandrashila Trek (≈5 Km Trek). Later Drive To Sitapur 2 Hrs Drive (≈54 Km)

- Wake up early in the morning and get ready for a walk.
- After breakfast, head to Tungnath Chandrashila Trek, the highest Shiva Temple in the country.
- Enter Tungnath after 5 km of trekking in the snowy
- mountains and pay your respect at the highest abode of Lord Shiva.
- After that, trek to Chandrashila's peak.
- Return by noon to the campground and travel to Sonprayag.
- Arrival at the Sitapur.







Day 03: Morning Sitapur Drive To GauriKund 7 km And Then Trek Towards Kedarnath Temple (21 Km Trek)


- Start early in the morning from Sonprayag and head for Gauri Kund after breakfast.
- Rejuvenate yourself by taking a bath in the hot spring of Holy Water (Gauri Kund).
- After that, from Gauri Kund, our actual trek starts, which is approximately 21 km to the temple of Kedarnath.
- This is a steep climb where we're going to walk with hundreds of people. Slowly, the forest gives way to the majestic views of Mount Kedarnath.
- We will hit the top in the evening, and in the evening we will be able to attend the Aarti evening in the temple.
- Remain at night near the Temple of Kedarnath.





Day 04: Trek Back To Gauri Kund, Then Night Stay At Sitapur.

- Wake up in the midst of heavenly beauty, watch the glorious golden rays of the rising sun fall upon the temple.
- After breakfast, go back to the Gauri Kund.
- Gaurikund to Sitapur night stay.







Day 05: Morning Sitapur Drive To Rishikesh (≈207 km)

Go back to the Rishikesh/Haridwar after breakfast


- 1. Dry fruits, Nuts, Chocolate bars
